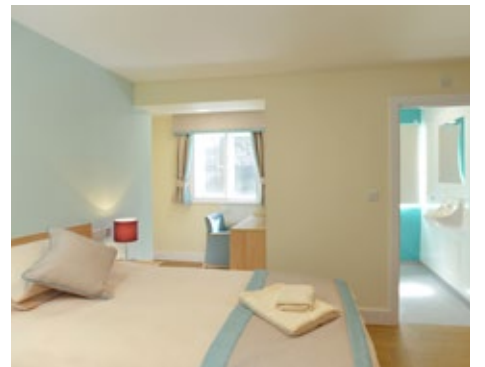


Autumn Leaf House

Autumn Leaf House is a specialist autism service situated on Chester Road in Castle Bromwich, a suburb of Solihull, in the West Midlands.



Introducing Autumn Leaf House

Autumn Leaf House is close to local amenities within a few miles of Birmingham and has good public transport links including major bus routes, train stations and the M6, M5 and M42 motorways linking it to major cities such as Manchester, London and Bristol.

This 'robust' service brings together the best qualities of a 'local' service with the support and expertise of an established and well-respected service provider.

Autumn Leaf House is a service for eight people aged 18 years and over with autism, but can accommodate people who are 17 years old and are going through transition from children's services. The staff team have significant expertise in supporting people with autism and are supported by a dedicated Positive Behaviour Support specialist and Autism Leads.

What we offer

- Three en-suite bedrooms
- Five self-contained flats
- Two lounges
- Separate dining room
- Modern kitchen
- A large garden
- Respite care

For accommodation, the service comprises of three en-suite bedrooms and five self-contained flats. The ground floor consists of two flats and two en-suite bedrooms, whilst the first floor is made up of three flats and one en-suite bedroom.

All of the flats have their own Activities of Daily Living (ADL) kitchens designed to promote independence whilst maintaining safety.



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

Living at Autumn Leaf House

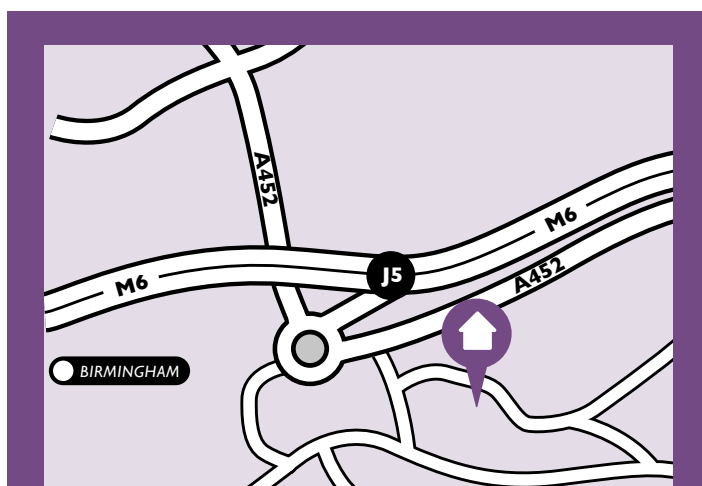
Amongst the services available are:

- Innovative person-centred support programmes and personal activity planners
- Intensive interactive communication and environment

- One-to-one specialist support as required
- Access to education and supported employment opportunities
- Progression through a care pathway to live as independently as possible
- Access to multi-professionals from allied healthcare practitioners and a dedicated positive behaviour support specialist
