Located in Leyland, Bannister Farm Cottage provides 24/7 specialist residential support for people with autism.



Introducing Bannister Farm Cottage

The people we support at Bannister Farm Cottage have high communication needs. To help promote their independence and community participation, we provide them with the skills and tools to communicate their needs and wants to others in a way that is deemed socially acceptable which, in turn, reduces the number of behaviours that challenge.

We promote the use of independent living skills and education so people we support can make informed choices about the life they want to live. Everyone living at Bannister Farm Cottage has an individualised support package that suits their

own specific needs. Everyone has their individual routines and structures which are known to them and help devise timelines to reduce anxiety.

Our team of highly skilled professionals have a vast knowledge and experience of working with people who have autism. Each member of staff receives regular training in specific areas, including the triad of impairments, so they have the ability and understanding of the people they support and how they see things around them - this in turn will provide the team with the skills to help support people in a more person-centred way.

Living at Bannister Farm Cottage

Bannister Farm Cottage is located in a semi-rural location of Leyland, approximately two miles from the town centre. The local shops are approximately 3/4 of a mile away, which offer a varied selection of goods. We have two vehicles on-site which can support people to access the community activities and public transport stops 500 meters from the site which will take you to Preston, Chorley and Leyland.

The specialist residential service is separated into three parts: the main house, which consists of two upstairs bedrooms and one downstairs bedroom, all en-suite. There is also a large communal kitchen and dining room, where people can eat and carry out independent activities, as well as two lounge areas so that people have a quiet place to relax and do their independent work or have meetings.

There is a large garden to the rear of the property which is divided into two areas - a large lawn area which is popular during the warmer months and a patio area.



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

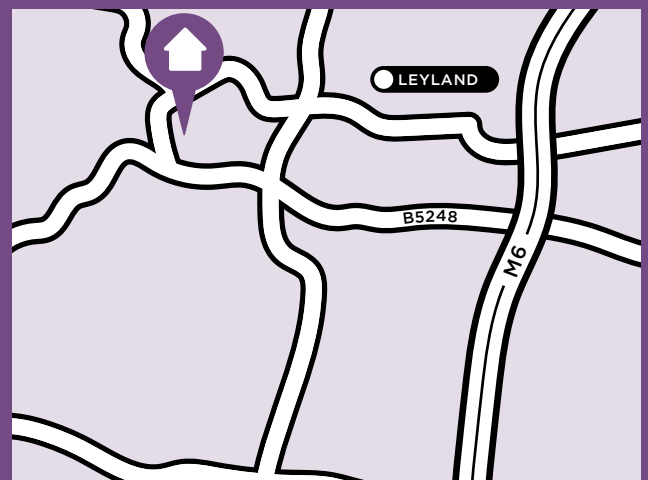
Achieving positive outcomes
