Living at Brickbridge House

Brickbridge House is located in the small village of Wombourne, South Staffordshire with easy access to local retailers. Health facilities such as dentist, GP and opticians are within walking distance, plus there are some great nature walks and canals where we often purchase boat trips or have picnics on the banks.

Brickbridge House is a six bedded home. Our facilities include:

- Four large downstairs bedrooms suitable for wheelchair users
- Two upstairs large bedrooms
- One bedded self-contained apartment on the grounds as well
- Large communal lounge and a kitchen
- A dining room where we have a large table for everyone to sit around at meal times, if desired
- Large gardens to the front and rear of the house
- On-site transport

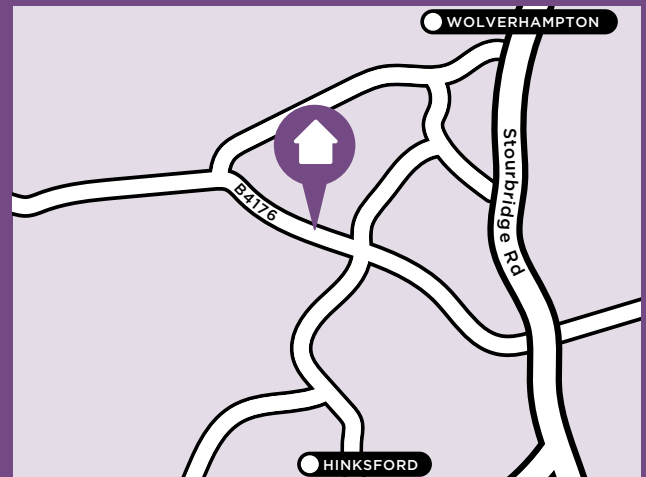
Admissions and referrals
