Introducing Caerlan

Llantrisant can be found north of Pontyclun and south of Pontypridd in the county of Rhondda Cynnon Taff, South Wales. The town sits between the rivers Ely and Clun and derives its name from the three saints, St Illtyd, St Dyfonwg and St Gwynno, with 'trisant' meaning 'three saints'.

The service is also close to the town centre and within walking distance of local amenities and major bus routes, train stations and motorways to major cities such as Cardiff, Swansea and Newport.

Caerlan also won the Pinders Healthcare Design Award for the Best New Care Facility within the 'Younger Adults' category in 2016. This prestigious design award has been running for 20 years and helps to promote the very best developments in care-related property, whilst also identifying the significant contribution individual sites are making to the quality of life and well-being of the people they support.

The people who live in Caerlan are aged from 18 and upwards, but we can accommodate people who are 17

and are going through transition from children's services.

Accommodation in the main house includes a ground floor apartment and ground floor en-suite bedroom. On the first floor there are two studio flats and two en-suite bedrooms. External to the main house there is also a self-contained bungalow. All of the flats have their own Activities of Daily Living (ADL) kitchen designed to promote independence whilst maintaining safety.

The main house also offers a large comfortable lounge, separate dining room, kitchen, quiet room and conservatory. There is also a meeting area and activities' room. This 'robust' service brings together the best qualities of a 'local' service with the support and expertise of an established and well respected service provider. The staff team have significant expertise in supporting people with autism and are supported by a dedicated positive behaviour support specialist and specialist autism leads.

- A low stimulus, homely and relaxed environment, whilst offering robust furnishings
- Spacious lounge areas, beautiful grounds and access to the wider community
- Innovative person-centred support programmes and personal activity planners
- Intensive interactive communication and environment
- A large garden that is safe and private

 - Three en-suite bedrooms
 - Three studio flats
 - A self-contained bungalow

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

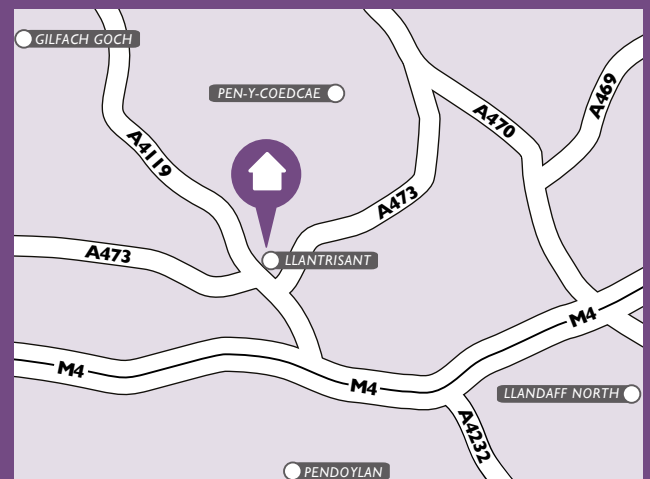
Referrals can be made through:
