Introducing Collinson Court

Some of our service users also have communication difficulties or present behaviours that challenge, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is also supported by a quality assurance team whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives, and where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

We offer person-centred support and all rooms are personalised to feel homely and suit the individual's needs and requirement.

Our services

- Specialist support for 12 people with autism who may also present mild to moderate/severe behaviours that challenge
- There are 4 single occupancy flats each containing their own lounge, kitchen, dining room and bedroom with en-suite facility, and 2 apartments each containing 4 single bedrooms with a wash basin, shared lounge, a diner, a bathroom and a kitchen
- One multi-sensory rooms, arts and crafts room and an activity room
- En-suite rooms are all compliant with the Disability Discrimination Act
- Non-invasive Proact Scip restraint technique
- Robust, low arousal accommodation, which exceeds the latest standards
- Access to education
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- 1:1 psychological support where needed
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- Service users can have their views heard via Priory Adult Care's communication strategy "Your Voice"
- Supported living, respite and community outreach transitional services

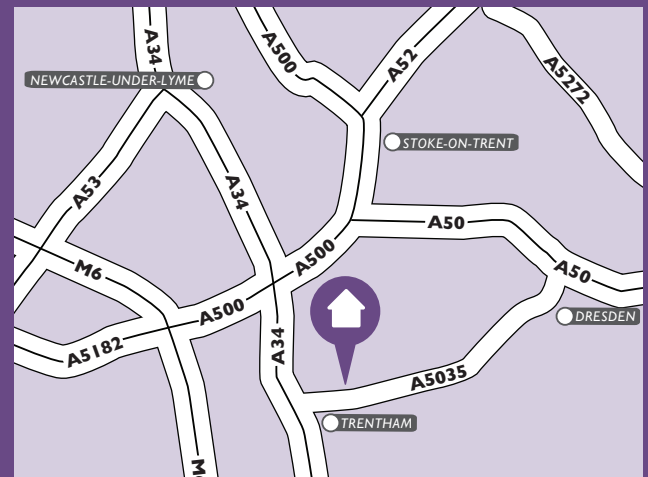
Admissions and referrals
