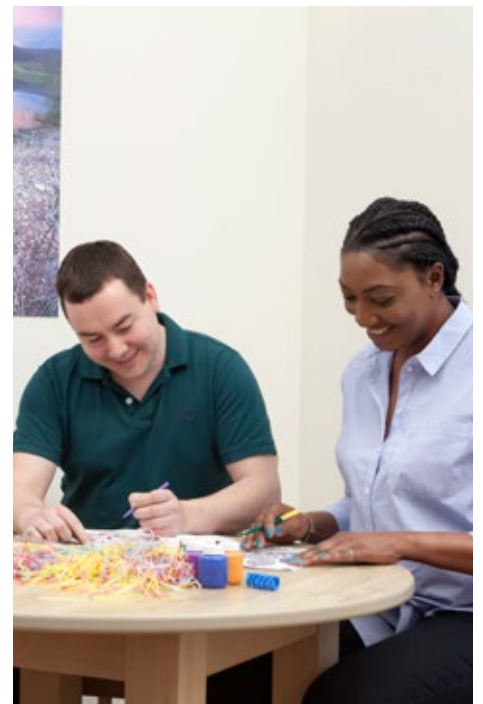


# Dolphin Lane

## Introducing Dolphin Lane

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Dolphin Lane offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all. The service is also supported by a quality assurance team including a specialist learning disability advisor whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives and, where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

## Our services

- Specialist support for 13 people with learning disabilities
- 13 places, all with en-suite facilities
- En-suite rooms are all compliant with the Disability Discrimination Act
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- One-to-one psychological support where needed
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Access to day-care facilities and local amenities
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- Multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Supported living, respite and community outreach transitional services
- Everyone is fully involved in the running of their home; from cooking meals to keeping the house tidy
- A wide range of activities to get involved with inside and outside the house; including going to the cinema, shopping or taking part in sport activities
- An on-site college that is run by Wakefield education authority that delivers an arts and crafts class and drama class

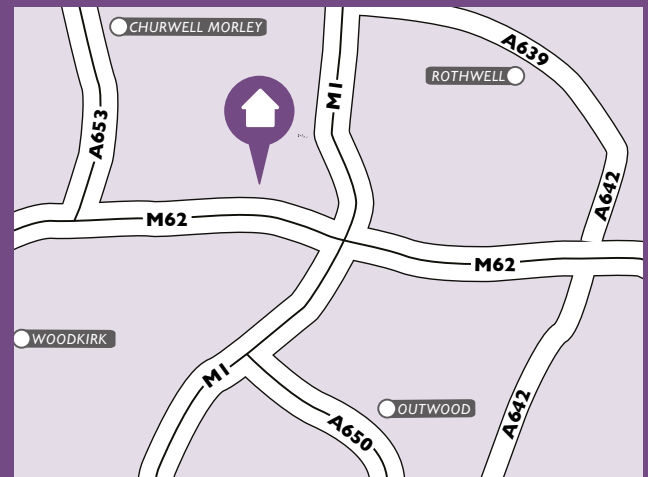
## Admissions and referrals
