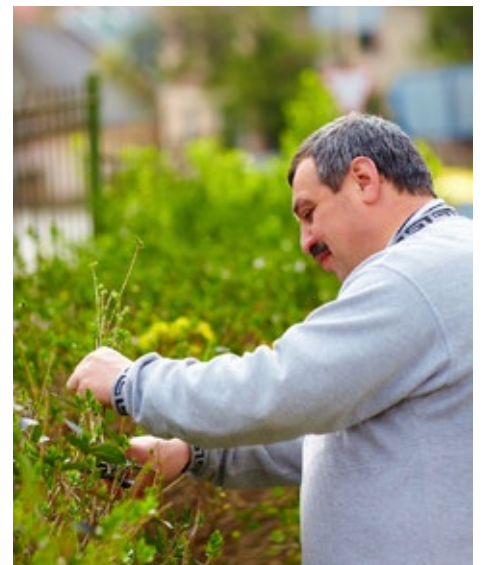


# Eastleigh House

## Introducing Eastleigh House

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We are highly skilled and experienced in working with individuals with communication challenges and the focus of our service is to support the individual to optimise their independence through skill and confidence development.

The service is also supported by a team of specialist autism advisors who through, Priory Adult Care's companywide autism strategy, empower service users to take control of their lives, and as far as possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

We have proven success in helping individuals to develop their level of independence and, where appropriate, can offer a seamless pathway, underpinned by consistency and continuity, to a supported living model delivered by our CQC registered domiciliary care agencies, "Supporting You", across England, Wales and Scotland. A number of people have come to Eastleigh House and gone on to develop their independence and then move back to their area of origin.

## Our services

- Specialist support for 10 people with autism, learning disabilities and associated needs
- Robust, low arousal accommodation, which exceeds the latest standards including 10 en-suite rooms, which are personalised to meet the individuals likes, wants and wishes
- A spacious dining room and lounge
- A multipurpose activity room with sensory equipment
- A training kitchen to promote independence with daily living skills and an extensive garden with swings and a trampoline
- External support from the local community learning disability team and an internal behavioural support therapist
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- A multidisciplinary staff team
- Service users can have their views heard via Priory Adult Care's communication strategy "Your Voice"



## Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

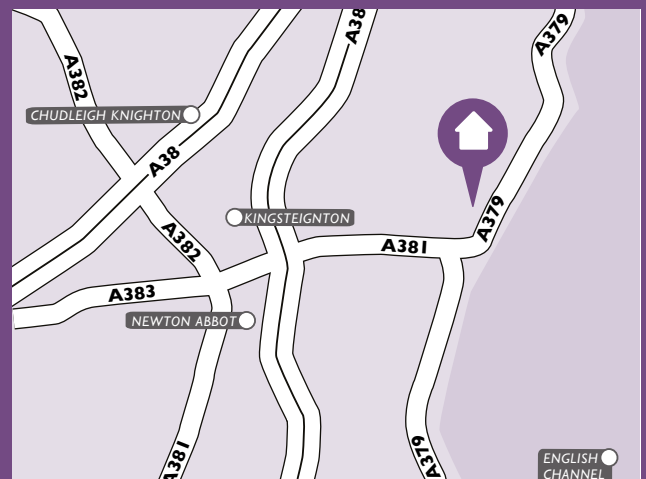
Referrals can be made through:
