Introducing Glebe House

Some of our service users also have communication difficulties and may also present complex conditions or have behaviours that challenge.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is also supported by a quality assurance team including a specialist Mental Health Advisor whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives, and where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

Our services

- 24 places, 21 of which have en-suite facilities
- Specialist support for up to 12 people with mental health problems who may require long term residential care
- Specialist support for up to 12 people with mental health problems within our rehabilitation facility, who may require short to medium term support through a rehabilitative and recovery focused pathway
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Links with our supported living service, Supporting You in Lincolnshire, which is also based at Glebe House
- Multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Respite, short break and community outreach transitional services



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

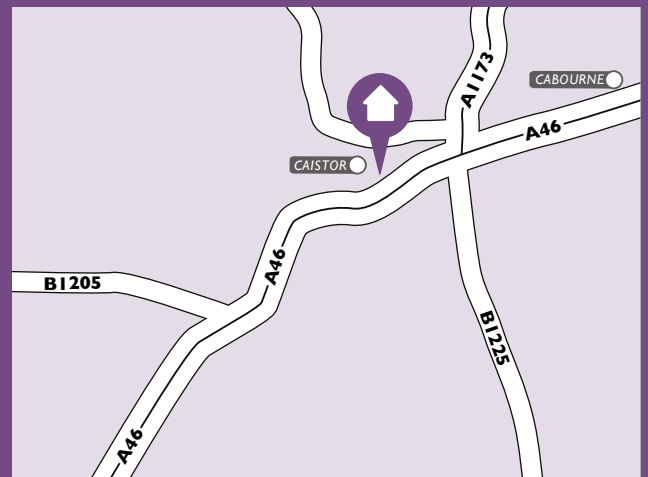
Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.
