Introducing Hamilton House

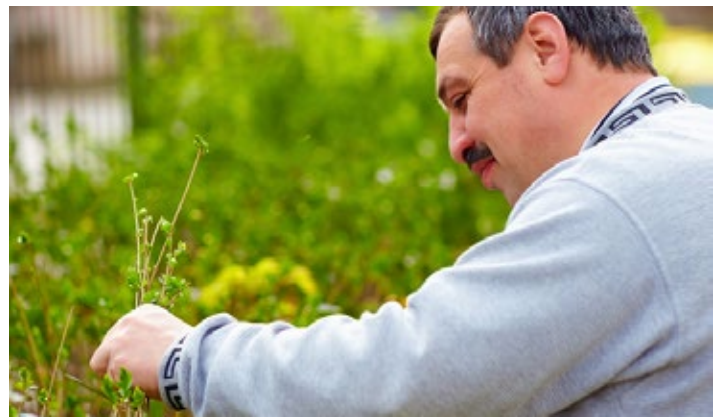
Some of our service users also have communication difficulties or present behaviours that challenge, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy and hearing difficulties.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop their self-esteem and the skills they need to live as independently as possible, to accomplish their goals and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is also supported by a team of specialist Autism Advisors who, through Priory Adult Care's company-wide Autism Strategy, empower service users to take control of their lives and, where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

- Specialist support for six people with autism who may also present mild to moderate behaviours that may be challenging
- Six places, all with en-suite facilities including one self-contained flat
- En-suite rooms are all compliant with the Disability Discrimination Act
- Non-invasive 'Studio 3' restraint technique
- Robust, low arousal accommodation, which exceeds the latest standards
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- Multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Supported living, respite and community outreach transitional services



Admissions and referrals

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

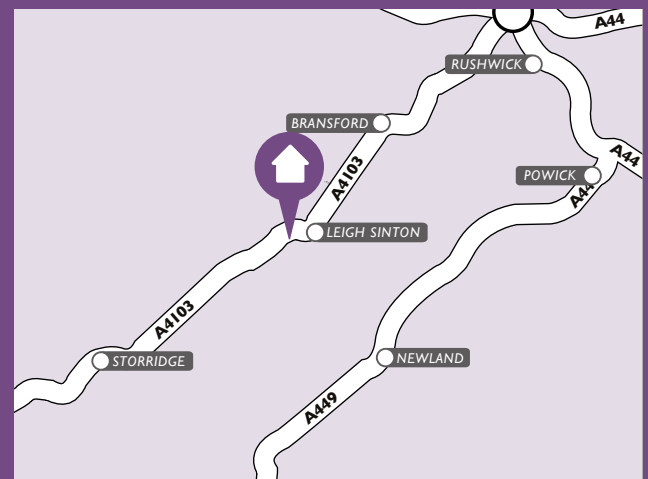
Referrals can be made through:
