Laburnum House is based in Folkestone, Kent and provides support for six adults with learning disabilities, autism, epilepsy and behaviours that challenge.



Introducing Laburnum House

Laburnum House provides assessment and support for adults living with a primary learning disability diagnosis but may present complex conditions. Some of our service users also have communication difficulties, physical disabilities or present behaviours that challenge, and predominately have dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy or Prader-Willi syndrome (PWS).

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all. The service is also supported by a quality assurance team including a positive behaviour support practitioner whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives, and where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

Our services

- Specialist support for six people with learning disabilities, mental health needs and behaviours that challenge
- A ground floor room and wet room available to accommodate somebody with mobility needs
- A spacious property comprising, two large lounges/quiet rooms, a dining room and kitchen
- A large multi-purpose garden with paved seating area to support recreational and horticultural activities
- Innovative person-centred service programmes working in conjunction with the individuals circles of support including family members and practitioners
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently including access to respite and community outreach
- A relationship with the wider multidisciplinary team including specialist practitioners such as an Epilepsy Nurse, CMH team, PWS practitioner
- Service users can have their views heard through your voice meetings



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

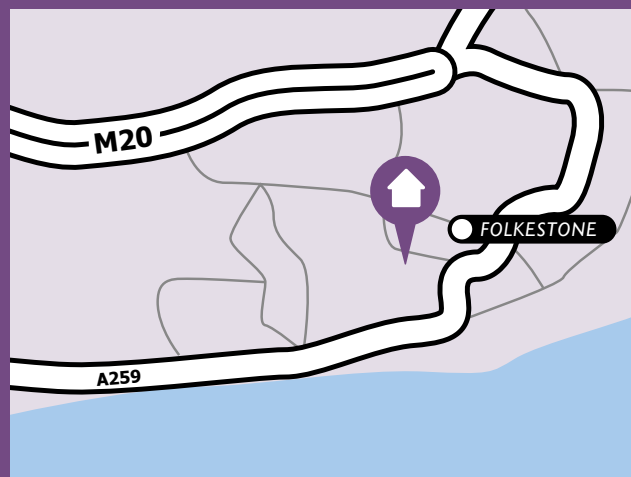
Referrals can be made through:
