Loughshore is a provision for people aged 18 years and over with complex needs including autism, learning disabilities and behaviours that challenge.



Introducing Loughshore

Loughshore is located in the Whiteabbey area of Greater Belfast, on the historic site of the former Lord Shaftsbury's home. Belfast City Centre is only six miles away with local shops, parks and a beach within walking distance of the service. Major bus and rail routes into Belfast City are also only a short distance from the home.

This robust and specifically designed service at Loughshore brings together the best qualities of a local service with the support and expertise of a well-respected service provider. The staff team have significant expertise in supporting people with complex needs and autism. They are also supported by a dedicated positive behaviour support specialist, as well as our specialist autism leads.

Living at Loughshore

The ground floor consists of 10 large, individually decorated bedrooms that all have full en-suite wet rooms. The ground floor operates in two separate elements splitting the 10 bedrooms into two sets of five bedrooms.

Across the ground floor there are four large living rooms and two separate dining rooms. The modern fitted kitchens are also large enough to have space for another table and chairs. The garden on the ground floor is fully secure and accessible to residents.

The first floor comprises of two large apartments with their own lounge, full wet room and an activities of daily living (ADL) kitchen to promote independence, whilst maintaining safety.

There are also four separate en-suite bedrooms and a large shared lounge. All the furniture and fittings have been designed with the residents in mind, being robust and homely.



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

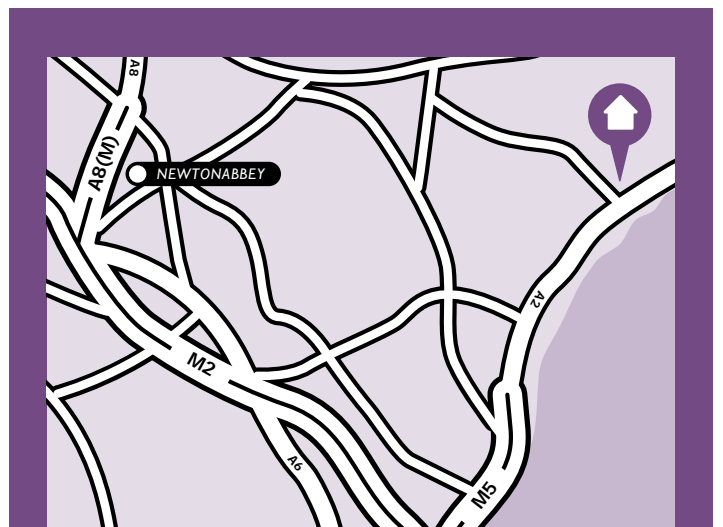
