Located in Glasgow, Maryhill offers semi-independent living and support with daily living skills for up to 10 adults with enduring mental illness.



Introducing Maryhill

At Maryhill there is 24 hour staff support onsite as well as access to full multidisciplinary and primary care services in the local area. The close proximity of the accommodation to town amenities enables residents to make the most of community activities and practice their independence.

The main aim of the service is to provide accommodation with quality and tailored, recovery based support for people with a mental health illness. This support will encourage and empower the people to engage within their community in a purposeful and meaningful way, and in realising their full potential, they will in time move on to less supported placements throughout the city.

Living at Maryhill

Residents at Maryhill are supported with daily living skills to maximise their independence and get involved in activities including shopping, budgeting and cooking.

Residents are encouraged to join various therapeutic groups within easy access of the service such as gardening, and computer and woodwork projects which can lead to work opportunities.

We encourage residents to visit prior to admission into Maryhill to meet other residents, with the option to also stay overnight.

Our staff team

The staff team at Maryhill includes a service manager, five senior support staff workers and seven support staff workers.

The service operates a keyworker system where a senior member of staff has the remit to provide the support and encouragement required to work alongside an individual to develop their own personal recovery support plan which will include recovery focused goals to work towards.

Our services

- A safe and therapeutic environment
- Comfortably furnished two-bedded independent flats with kitchen facilities
- Staff on-site 24 hours a day
- Therapeutic and community activities
- Easy access to the communities of Maryhill, Partick and Glasgow
- Opportunities for residents to visit nearby town centre amenities and participate in voluntary work
- Visitors are welcome

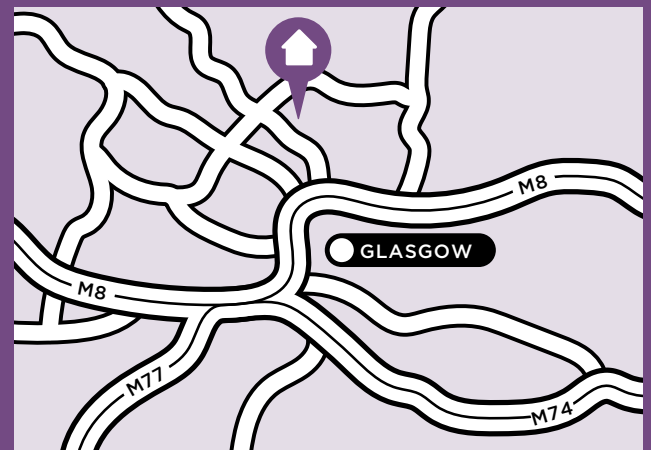
Admissions and referrals
