## Living at Red House

The atmosphere at Red House is relaxed, and is focused around individuals' involvement as they make the decisions that affect their home. Each person has their own bedroom, many of which include washing facilities. Everyone is encouraged and supported to personalise their bedrooms.

At Red House, we continually and consistently promote the development of social skills, independent living and personal responsibility. This includes daily skills such as shopping, cooking, doing laundry and cleaning, and tasks are dependent upon an individual's ability. The people who live here are very proud of their home as they have so much involvement in creating it.

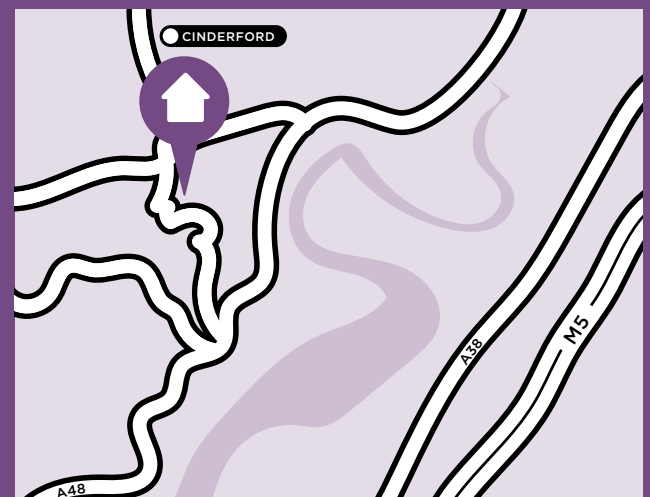
## Admissions and referrals
