Located on the outskirts of Glasgow, Riddrie House is a purpose-built care home with a nursing service, offering accommodation and personal care for 32 men and women with an enduring mental illness.



## Introducing Riddrie House

---

At Riddrie House, residents benefit from support with personal and daily living skills, as well as other needs in a community setting where they can reach their potential and achieve positive outcomes.

## Living at Riddrie House

At Riddrie House, the well-qualified staff team offer 24 hour support for residents to enable them to work towards rehabilitation and recovery. Multidisciplinary services including psychiatrists, psychologists and primary care services are accessed within the local area as required.

Residents are encouraged to utilise community facilities and to participate in local groups where applicable. In-house, the rehabilitation facilities give residents the opportunity to improve or maintain activities of daily living such as shopping, budgeting and cooking.

Prior to admission, we offer planned visits, gradually building up to overnight stays, which gives individuals the opportunity to meet other residents and to join in with activities. This also helps prospective residents make an informed choice about whether they wish to live at Riddrie House.



## Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

- 32 comfortably furnished bedrooms
- Rehabilitation kitchen facilities
- Spacious communal areas

- Most staff have either SVQ 2 or 3 in Health and Social Care qualifications
- Residents have easy access to the community
