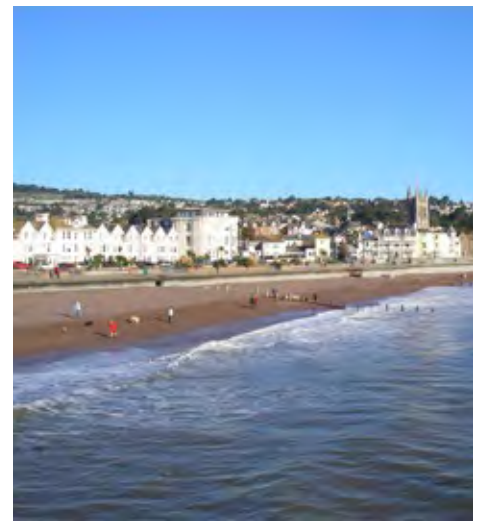


Riverview

Introducing Riverview

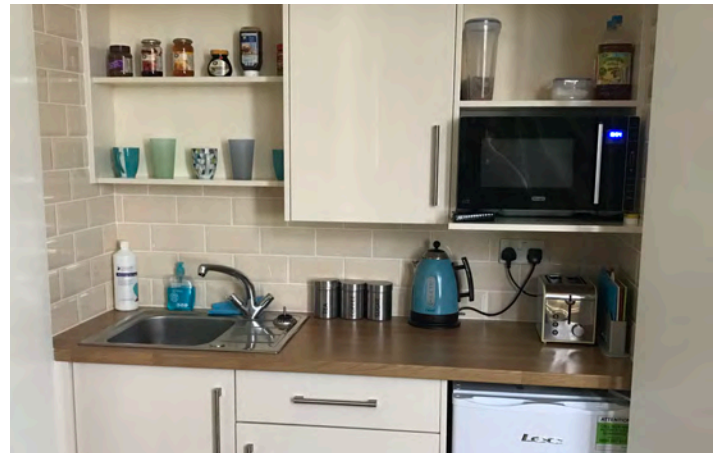
We are highly skilled and experienced in working with individuals with communication challenges and the focus of our service is to support the individual to optimise their independence through skill and confidence development.

Riverview is supported by a team of specialist autism and positive behavioural support advisors who, through Priory Adult Care's company-wide Autism Strategy, empower service users to take control of their lives and, as far as possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations. The service also receives input from a regional PBS practitioner who supports the staff team and the people we support by developing person-centred PBS plans and overseeing implementation.

We have proven success in helping individuals to develop their level of independence and, where appropriate, can offer a seamless pathway, underpinned by consistency and continuity, to a supported living model delivered by our CQC registered domiciliary care agencies, 'Supporting You', across the UK. A number of people have come to our service and gone on to develop their independence and then moved back to their area of origin.

Our services

- Specialist support for nine service users with autism, acquired brain injury (ABI) and/or behaviours that challenge
- Two rooms both with en-suite bathrooms
- Six self-contained flats with en-suite bedrooms, own lounge and kitchen to promote daily living skills
- Robust, low arousal accommodation, which exceeds the latest standards including en-suite rooms, compliant with the Disability Discrimination Act
- Detached property with secured garden
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- A multidisciplinary staff team
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently, where appropriate
- Service users can have their views heard via Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Quiet area, multipurpose room



Admissions and referrals

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

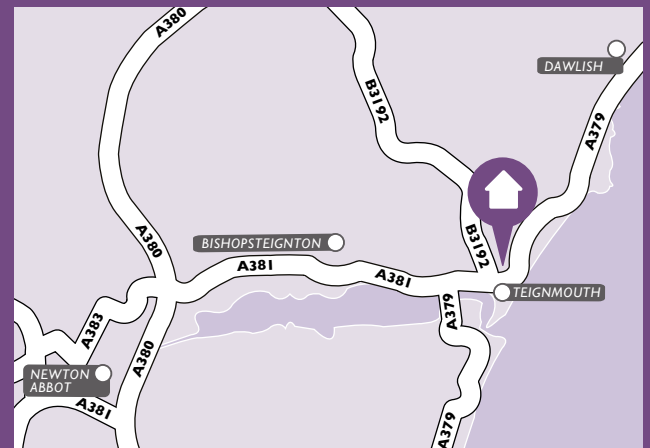
Referrals can be made through:
