Rose Court supports 10 adults with learning disabilities, autism and other associated complex needs.



Introducing Rose Court

Located just outside Luton, Rose Court is within a 10 minute bus ride of the town centre. We are also very close to the train station making it easy to have days out in London, and are 15 minutes away from London Luton airport. Rose Court also has a private car that can be used for day trips and travel to and from social events as needed.

Individuals at the home are encouraged to prepare meals for themselves and staff are on hand to offer support if required. Where appropriate, individuals are also encouraged to take care of their own laundry in either of our two laundry rooms. Experienced staff teams are on hand to provide 24 hour support where necessary, although many of the individuals we support enjoy independent lives where they go to college or have a job.

Living at Rose Court

Rose Court has a robust activity programme that was devised with individuals and offers a range of activities that are all community based. A typical weeks programme would include electronic learning, dance classes, employment, swimming, bowling, cinema trips, visits to other towns and villages, floral arranging and independent cooking. In the immediate area we have a newsagents, a pub, medical centre and a community centre.



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.



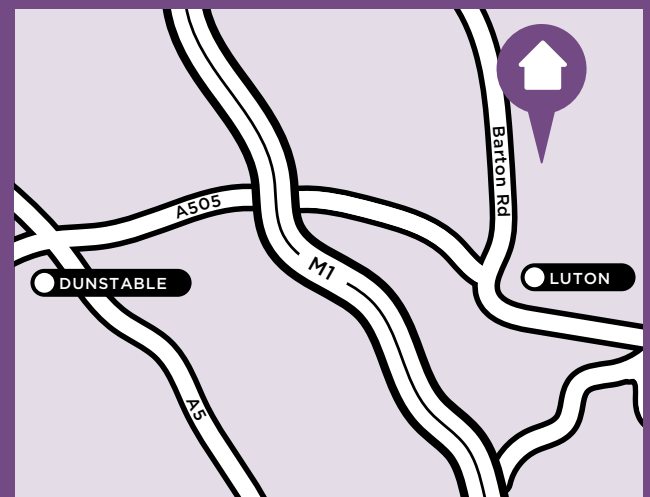
Achieving positive outcomes
