Introducing Rose Farm House

Rose Farm House, which was formerly part of the HQL group, provides assessment and specialist support for adults with profound, severe and moderate learning disabilities and/or autistic spectrum conditions, who sometimes present with severe behaviours that challenge.

Some of our service users also have communication difficulties and other conditions such as epilepsy. The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to empowering and encouraging the individuals who live there.

Staff will provide the support needed to enable them to reach their goals and to develop their self-esteem and the skills they need to live as independently as possible. The service is also supported by our person-centred approaches team who provide positive behaviour support strategies to individuals using the service, and their team of support staff, to enable them to achieve positive outcomes.

Our services

- Specialist support for five people with an intellectual disability and/or autism who may also present with severe behaviours that challenge
- We have two self-contained flats attached to the main house, and 3 main bedrooms within the main house
- Robust, low arousal, homely accommodation, which exceeds the latest standards
- Proact SCIPr UK support strategies
- Access to education, voluntary and paid employment opportunities
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- One-to-one psychological and psychiatric support where needed
- A multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

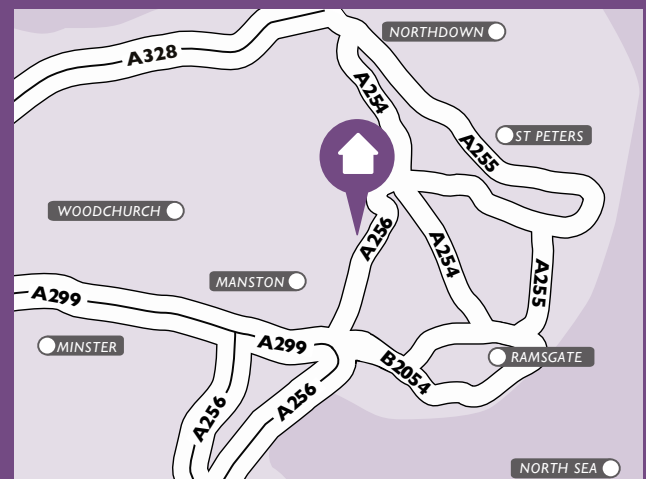
Referrals can be made through:
