

Spode Close

Located in Swindon, Spode Close is a specialist residential service for seven adults with autism and other complex needs.



Introducing Spode Close

This seven bed service is spread over three floors and brings together the best qualities of a 'local' service with the support and expertise of an established and well-respected service provider. Each floor has two en-suite bedrooms with their own individual kitchenettes, with an additional apartment on the second floor, all offering a homely environment that promotes independent living. The home also has two communal lounges, two shared kitchens and two communal bathrooms.

Spode Close is a service for people aged 18 years and over, however it can accommodate individuals that are 17 years old and who are going through transition from children's services, having been identified via the Transforming Care Agenda.

The staff team have significant experience and expertise in supporting people with complex autism, learning disabilities and behaviours that challenge. A dedicated positive behaviour support practitioner is also part of the staff team.

The service is close to local amenities and has good public transport links with easy access to major bus routes, train stations and the M4 motorway linking it to major cities such as York, London and Bristol. Priory Adult Care is also competent in adhering to the Mental Capacity Act in making best interest decisions and, when necessary, making applications to the Local Authority under Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards.

Living at Spode Close

Split over three floors, our facilities include:

- 7 bedded service with en-suite facilities
- 2 spacious lounges
- Individual kitchenettes
- 2 shared communal kitchens and bathrooms
- Separate activity room
- Large garden



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

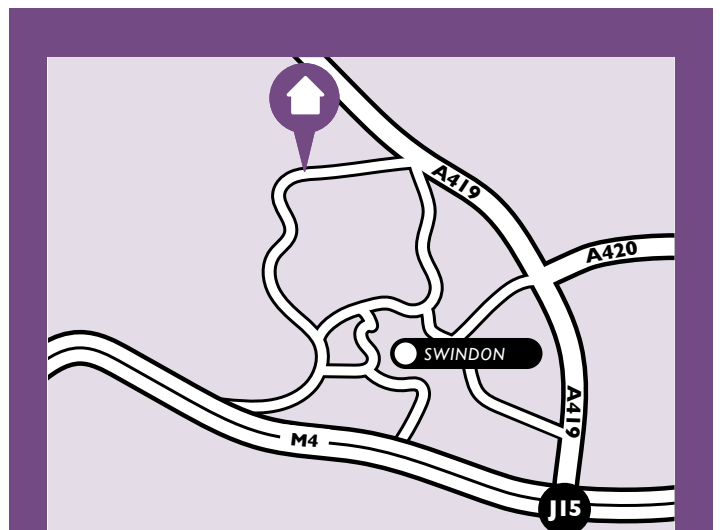
Our services
