Some of the people we support also have communication difficulties or present behaviours that challenge, and predominately have dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy or Down's Syndrome.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes.

The Foam supports up to three adults with learning disabilities, physical disabilities and behaviours that challenge. We offer quality support, which is based on respect for each individual and their right to make choices about the support they receive.

## Andy's story

Andy\* moved to The Foam four years ago following several failed placements. Andy first required high levels of staff support, 24 hours a day, due to his complex behaviours and his general health.

Andy's poor eating and drinking in the first four months resulted in him staying in hospital for periods of time. With the support provided by our staff team, he made a positive recovery and his general health greatly improved. Andy was also on high levels of psychotropic medicines, which we started the process of reducing safely, working closely with the specialty doctor. This has taken over two years and with lots of positive support, Andy is no longer taking any psychotropic medication, excluding a minimal dose, which he cannot be taken off.

We are delighted with the progress Andy has made at The Foam. He is now a lot happier, healthier and enjoying his life.
