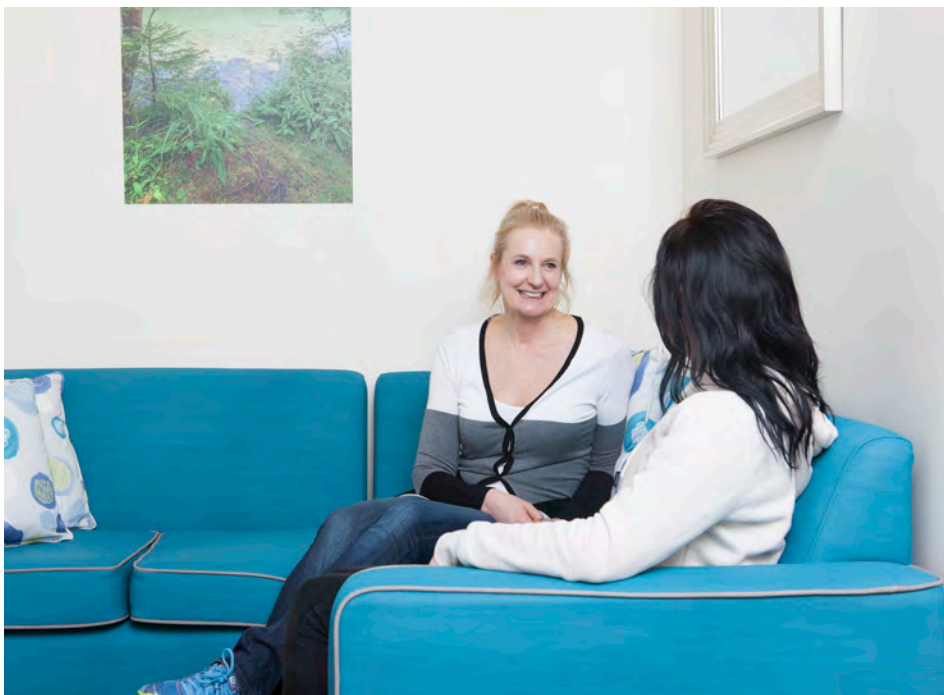


# Wells Road

Wells Road provides assessment and support for females living with mental health needs, a primary learning disability diagnosis but may present complex conditions.



## Introducing Wells Road

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Some of our service users also have mental health issues or present behaviours that challenge, and predominantly have dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy or autism.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is also supported by a quality assurance team whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives and, where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

## Our services

- Specialist support for six females with mental health needs or a learning disability who may also present mild to moderate challenging behaviour and high emotional needs
- A beautiful Edwardian property with light, spacious rooms, six bedrooms all with en-suite facilities
- Located a short walk from Bristol town centre, local shopping centre, train station and public transport routes
- Person-centred support programmes tailored to individual needs, goals and wishes delivered in a safe and caring environment
- 'Behaviour Activation Approach' to daily planning to promote physical and mental health and wellbeing
- Access to education and employment opportunities
- Proactive approach to the management of a crisis using 'PROACT-SCIPr-UK' technique
- Service users can have their views heard via Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently



## Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

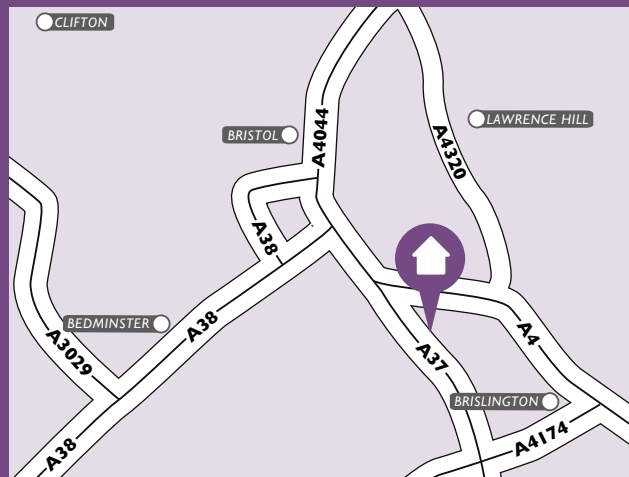
Referrals can be made through:
