Introducing Mount View House

Mount View House is a seven bedded specialist autism service within easy reach of local amenities. It has good public transport links including access to main bus routes, a train station and the M62 motorway linking it to Huddersfield, Rochdale and cities such as Manchester, Leeds and Liverpool.

The service supports people aged 18 years and over, but can accommodate people who are 17 years old, transitioning from children's services and who have been identified through the transforming care agenda.

The staff team have significant expertise in supporting people with autism and behaviours that challenge, and is supported by a dedicated positive behaviour support (PBS) specialist.

This specialist service brings together the best qualities of a local service with the support and expertise of an established and well-respected service provider.

Living at Mount View House

- Four en-suite bedrooms
- Two apartments
- A separate detached apartment
- Comfortable lounges
- Spacious dining room
- Modern kitchen
- A large private garden

For the accommodation, Mount View House has seven robust beds which comprise of four en-suite bedrooms and two apartments within the main building, each with their own front door, and a separate detached apartment.

All the apartments have their own activities of daily living (ADL) kitchens designed to promote independence, whilst maintaining safety and separate entrances.
