## Introducing Apple Mews

Apple Mews has been developed to provide care for up to 30 adults with learning disabilities, autism and complex physical disabilities. It will provide nursing care and a range of programmes to support the development of independence and life skills. Residents will also have access to daily activities including arts, music, education, sensory and outdoor activities.

A variety of day trips to places of interest are organised by the home, as well as holidays that are further afield. Residents are invited to suggest ideas for these trips at our regular meetings,

which also provide individuals with the chance to provide feedback about their care.

There are a wide range of local activities on offer to residents both on and off-site such as; board games, outings to swimming pools and other local facilities as well as use of our quiet room where individuals can access a safe and secure computer. Our life skills coach organises a range of daily activities both in and out of the home that are planned in conjunction with the wishes of those who use our service.

## Living at Apple Mews

Situated in Armagh, we are conveniently located near good public amenities including pubs, cinemas, cafes and swimming pools and are within easy access of public transport.

We hold the philosophy that each person should take the lead in their care programme. We understand that each person has different needs, interests and hobbies, which is why personal input is so important.

Apple Mews is made up of five bungalows, each comprising of six en-suite bedrooms and specially designed to provide a cosy and homely feel for residents. Each room is fully furnished and can easily be personalised at an individual's request.

We have spacious communal rooms where everyone can relax and entertain their visitors; the rooms are equipped with televisions and radios for everybody's enjoyment. We have a separate area where individuals can socialise and enjoy their favourite beverage.

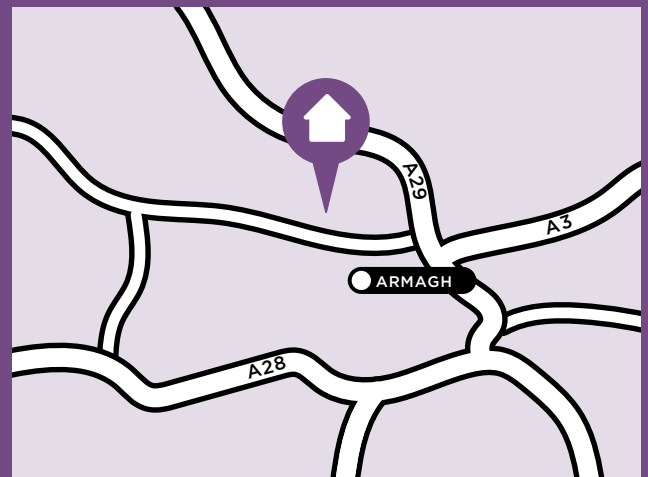
## Admissions and referrals
