Introducing Kinsley Autism Services

Some of the people that we support also have communication difficulties or present with behaviours that challenge, and predominately have dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy. Kinsley Autism Services is a specialist day care service, offering care when you need it.

The service is open seven days a week from early morning to late evenings. Kinsley Autism Services is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop their self-esteem, and the skills they need to live as independently as possible and to accomplish their goals. At Kinsley Autism Services, no goal is too big or small. Staff work as a small core group so that they get to understand a person's needs, and the individual gets to know and trust the staff members that are working with them. This enables the person to live a fulfilled independent life with just enough support through an in-depth knowledge of their autism, which is what we are about.

Our services

- Specialist support for people with autism who may also present with mild to moderate behaviours that challenge
- Activities, including swimming, going to the cinema, rambling and arts and crafts sessions
- Development of social skills, independent living and personal responsibility. This includes daily living skills such as shopping, cooking, doing laundry and cleaning tasks, dependent upon each individual's ability
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- 1:1 psychological support where needed
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- A multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people that we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.

Achieving positive outcomes

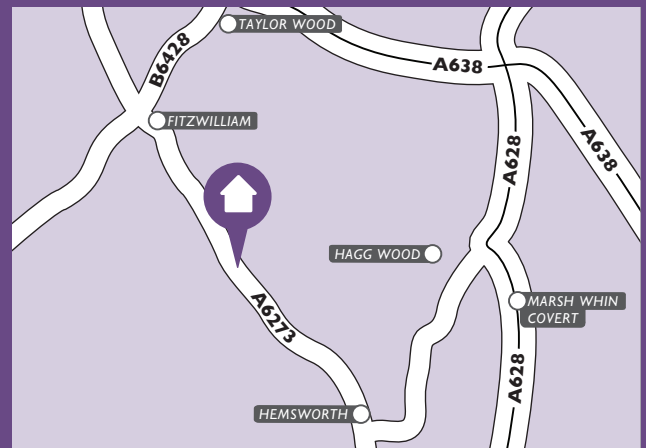
By encouraging people to take control and have belief in their potential, we can make positive outcomes a reality for everyone, regardless of age or presumed ability.
