Abbey House, part of the Whitby scheme, is a newly developed residential service set in the beautiful and tranquil coastal town of Whitby.



Introducing Abbey House

The house is situated in an ideal location close to several towns and cities such as Middlesbrough, Scarborough, Wakefield, Tyneside, Leeds, and York. It's also close to local amenities and places of interest, and is accessible by road and train, with a bus stop right outside the house.

Abbey House offers rehabilitation and support for females with mental health illnesses and personality disorders that may have a forensic background with associated complex and challenging behaviours.

This service will provide transitional support through an integrated pathway for service users who no longer require intensive support in hospital or a secure unit, yet continue to present a level of risk that requires a fully supported and staffed environment.

The scheme will provide an integrated step down service from hospital, locked rehabilitation, or step up from the community where an individual is identified as currently having difficulty coping. We encourage recovery and re-enablement, and will include the offer of Positive Behaviour Support and Recovery Star outcomes, to reintegrate individuals back into their own community life at an individualised pace.

Our services

- Six individual rooms, four of which offers en-suite facilities
- Positive Behaviour Support and Recovery Model
- Access to community projects/programmes/ education
- Direct links/involvement with Supporting You
- Specialist support for up to six females with mental health issues who may also present behaviours that challenge
- Staff trained in positive behaviour support and mental health awareness
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- A multidisciplinary community team
- Service users can have their views heard via Priory Adult Care's communication strategy "Your Voice"
- Supported living, respite and community outreach transitional services



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

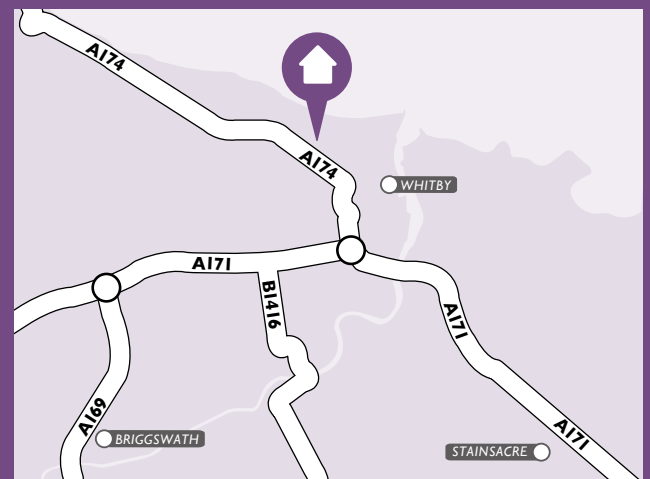
Referrals can be made through:
