Manor Field is a five bedded specialist autism service situated in Corby, Northamptonshire.



## Introducing Manor Field

Manor Field provides person-centred residential care for young adults aged 18 years and over, but can accommodate 17 year olds who are preparing for adulthood. This 'robust' service brings together the best qualities of a 'local' service with the support and expertise of an established and well-respected service provider.

The service is close to local amenities and within easy access to major bus routes, train stations and motorways linking it to the neighbouring towns of Kettering, Peterborough, Luton, Milton Keynes and to Essex, London and Birmingham.

The staff team have significant expertise in supporting people with autism and behaviours that challenge. A dedicated positive behaviour support (PBS) Specialist and specialist Autism Leads will also be offered.

## Living at Manor Field

- 2 en-suite bedrooms
- 3 self-contained apartments, both with their own activities of daily living (ADL) kitchens designed to promote independence whilst maintaining safety
- A very spacious lounge and dining area with patio doors leading onto a large, secure garden
- A modern kitchen

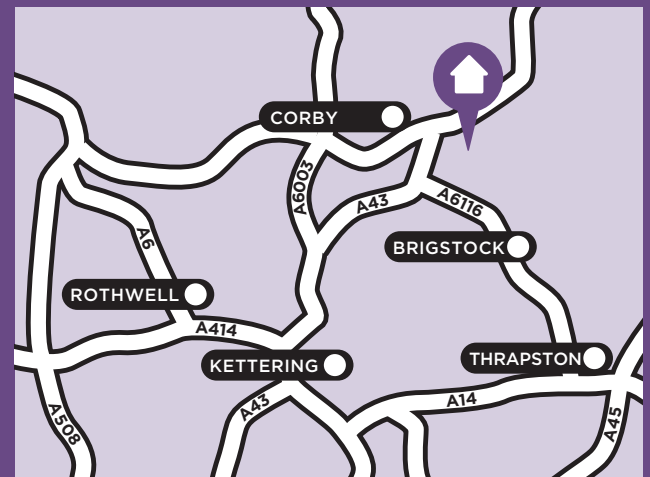
## Admissions and referrals
