At Blyton Court, we provide assessment and long term care for the people we support who have a wide range of learning and physical disabilities together with associated difficulties, to lead happy and fulfilled lives. Our service users are at the heart of all we do which is why we provide assessment and support.

Located in Blyton, Gainsborough, the service has 17 single occupancy rooms; all decorated to high standards with modern furnishings and fittings, specifically tailored to each of our service users tastes & needs. Everyone is encouraged to personalise their own space, decorating with pictures and photographs.



## Our services

- 24 hour nursing care
- A dedicated activities co-ordinator, delivering a range of planned activities for residents, including both on-site and community-based activities
- Local GP support
- Access to psychological, occupational and physiotherapy where there is an assessed need
- A mobility-adapted minibus to enable access to community resources
- A convenient location, close to local amenities and central to Gainsborough, Scunthorpe, Lincoln and Grimsby
- Service users and family members can have their views heard via the monthly "Our Voice" meetings

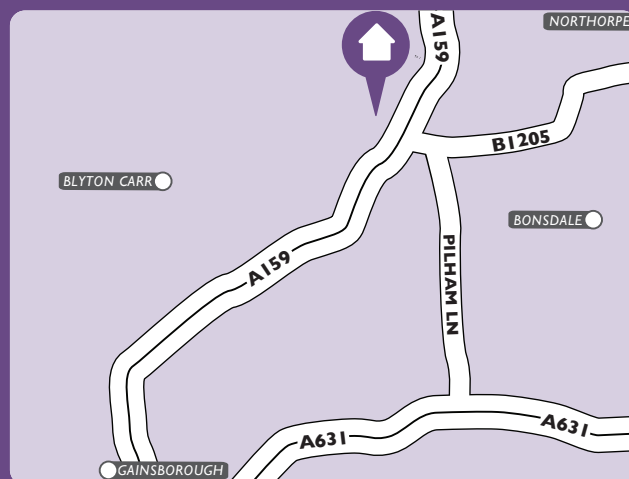
## Admissions and referrals
