Long Lane Farm provides 24/7 specialist residential support for four adults with autism and learning disabilities, who may also present complex/challenging behaviour.



Introducing Long Lane Farm

Using a person-centred approach, we enable all individuals to make their own choices about the support they receive. We improve their wellbeing and are focused on achieving positive outcomes for everyone in a safe and supportive environment.

Living at Long Lane Farm

All people at Long Lane Farm can benefit from a wide range of activities within the service and in the local community. The people that we support are encouraged through their person-centred plans to achieve their goals and aspirations. For some people this means attending college to access various courses including art and cooking. Within the house, we continually promote the development of social skills, independent living and personal responsibility. This includes daily skills which are dependent upon an individual's ability such as:

- Budgeting
- Cleaning
- Laundry
- Cooking
- Gardening
- Shopping

The service also promotes Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice', which encourages individuals based on their preferred method of communication to share their views about the support they receive. Monthly meetings are held where individuals are able to represent the views and voices of themselves and others living at the service.

Our services

- A detached farmhouse consisting of three individual bedrooms
- Spacious communal areas including a lounge, dining room and kitchen
- A separate annex for one person consisting of a lounge/dining area with kitchen facilities, bedroom and en-suite bathroom
- Person-centred approach through both community and home-based activities
- A highly skilled and dedicated staff team
- Within easy access to local shops, amenities and transport links
- 'Your Voice' meetings where individuals are encouraged to share their views

Achieving positive outcomes

By encouraging people to take control and have belief in their potential, we can make positive outcomes a reality for everyone, regardless of age or presumed ability.

We create pathways that support individuals through residential to community living, delivering measurable results for both local authorities and the people who use our services. 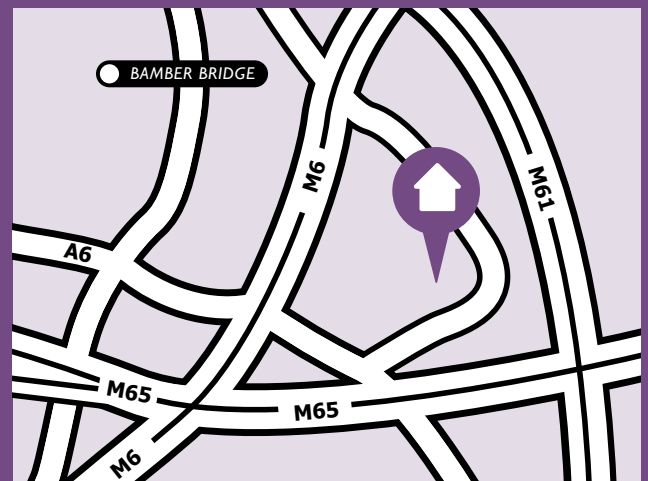
Admissions and referrals
