Introducing Vaughan House

Some of the people that we support at Vaughan House also have communication difficulties or present behaviours that may challenge, and predominately have a dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities including epilepsy or mental health needs.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing just enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is supported by a quality assurance team who aim to empower the residents to take control of their lives, and where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations. Staff members also regularly undertake personal behaviour support and face-to-face training to offer the right support to the people we care for.

We offer person-centred support and encourage individual's to personalise their rooms to make them feel homely, and suit their needs and requirements.

Our services

- Specialist support for 10 male adults with learning disabilities, who may also present mild behaviours that challenge
- 10 bedrooms, 5 with en-suite facilities and the other 5 with wash basins
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Access to education and paid employment opportunities
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

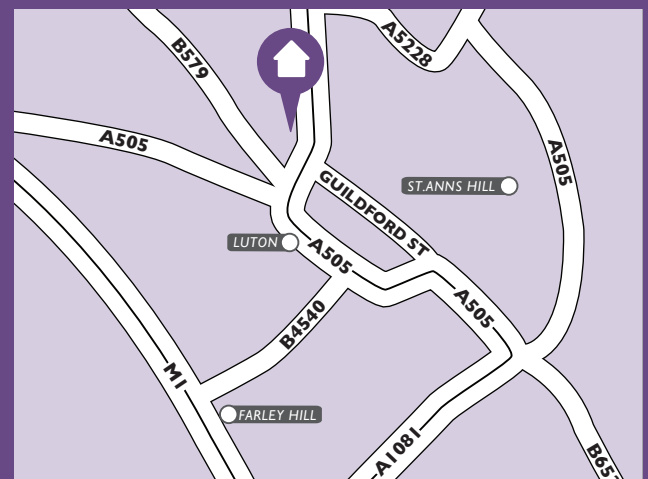
Referrals can be made through:
