Introducing The Shieling

The Shieling provides assessment and support for adults living with a primary learning disability diagnosis but may present complex conditions. Some of our service users also have communication difficulties or present behaviours that challenge, and predominantly have dual diagnosis, as well as a range of other disabilities such as epilepsy or cerebral palsy.

The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support and is committed to providing enough support to empower and encourage individuals to develop the skills they need to live as independently as possible and achieve positive outcomes for all.

The service is also supported by a quality assurance team including a specialist Learning Disability Advisor whose aim is to empower service users to take control of their lives and, where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

Our services

- Specialist support for 10 people with learning disabilities who may also present mild to moderate challenging behaviour
- Nine spacious rooms in the main house plus the Coach House which is a self-contained flat
- Non-invasive 'Proact Scip' training
- En-suite rooms are all compliant with the Disability Discrimination Act
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- One-to-one psychological support where needed
- Access to education and personal activity opportunities
- Progression through a care pathway that fulfils each individual's maximum potential to live more independently
- A multidisciplinary staff team
- Interaction within Priory Adult Care's communication strategy 'Your Voice'
- Supported living, respite and community outreach
- transitional services



Admissions and referrals

At Priory Adult Care, we can offer advice about accessing benefits and funding if appropriate.

We support people on how best to spend an individual budget or direct payment to make sure the people we support can live the life they want.

Referrals can be made through:

- The individual's social services department management team or, if relevant, their local health authority
- By the individual (or an appropriate adult acting on their behalf) who wishes to use direct payment, individual budget, or who is self-financing.
