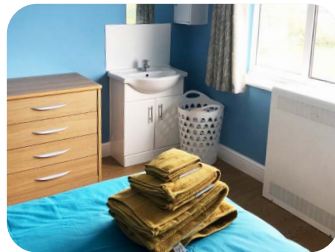
The service offers 24/7 specialist residential support for eight adults with autism, learning disabilities and complex needs.

We provide person-centred support and focus on encouraging individuals to take control of their lives, achieve their own wishes, personal goals and positive outcomes. Our dedicated and passionate staff team are also fully trained to support individuals with a range of complex needs.



Our services

- A specialist residential service for adults with a learning disability, who may also present with behaviours that challenge, and predominantly have a dual diagnosis
- Accommodation comprising of 7 bedrooms overlooking the sea or local golf course
- A separate unit specifically designed to further develop independence skills and help prepare individuals with transitioning on to supported living services. The unit includes a bedroom, lounge and bathroom
- A range of shared facilities, including a spacious kitchen, lounge, dining area, quiet room, and 2 wet rooms, 1 of which is located on the ground floor
- A large garden and patio area, suitable for BBQs
- Rated 'Good' in all assessment areas by the Care Quality Commission (CQC)
- Access to local college courses and a day service
- A long standing and highly experienced multidisciplinary team
- A convenient location situated on the beach front, within the village of New Romney. Easy access to walks and nearby facilities, including shops and restaurants
- Excellent transport links, with the main bus route only a 5-minute walk away, offering access to nearby locations, including Folkestone, Hythe and Ashford

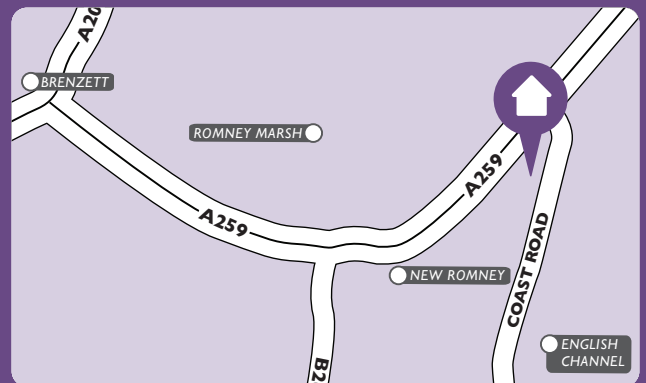
Admissions and referrals
