## Introducing Brunswick Mews

The self-contained flats at Brunswick Mews are specifically designed for individuals who are not fully ready to move into a supported living environment. The new service supports three adults with a range of complex needs, including autism, learning disabilities and mental health needs.

Our flats provide an ideal pathway to help ensure that the people we support progress to a less restrictive environment, equipped with the skills required to live as independently as possible.

The accommodation is also ideal for:

- Individuals whose placements may be breaking down in the community, as they can live for a period of time in an environment where they will not lose their daily living skills
- Individuals stepping down from a hospital setting or moving from family homes to increase independence into adult life, and developing essential life skills to live and thrive within the community and further afield

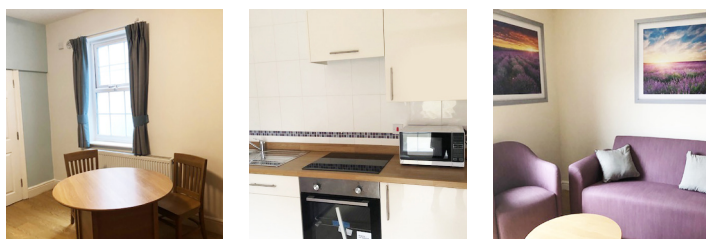
## An environment supporting recovery

We believe that the environment is as important as the therapy provided. Our service offers:

- Close access to the local community and amenities
- Community trips
- Support with communication needs
- Social functions for residents, their families and friends

Brunswick Mews provides three spacious self-contained flats in a residential/community setting. The flats include:

- En-suite bedrooms
- Activities of daily living (ADL) kitchens, designed to promote independence whilst maintaining safety
- Access to garden areas



## Our multidisciplinary team

Our team consists of:

- A positive behaviour support (PBS) practitioner
- Key workers
- Recovery workers/support workers

## Therapeutic activities

Support at Brunswick Mews focuses on building our residents' independence and can include the following therapeutic activities:

- Cooking skills development
- Individual budgeting plans
- Personal and environmental care support
- Vocational skills development
- Arts and crafts
- Social activities
- Access to local sports activities and colleges/educational facilities
- Fitness sessions



## Placement criteria

Brunswick Mews is suitable for people that fit the following profile:

- Adults aged 18 years and over
- Presenting with learning disabilities
- Presenting with autism
- Presenting with mental health needs
- Presenting with complex behavioural needs

This service offers an ideal placement for:

- Individuals who have been in a hospital setting for a substantial period of time and are part of the Learning Disability and Autism Programme (LDAP), formerly known as the Transforming Care Agenda
- Individuals who have had a community-based placement breakdown, to prevent a hospital admission
