**Homeleigh Farm is a specialist residential service for six male adults with learning disabilities and other complex needs.**



## Introducing Homeleigh Farm

At Homeleigh Farm, we support up to six males with learning disabilities and behaviours that may challenge, as well as a Prader-Willi syndrome or a forensic history of offending. This specialist residential service is surrounded by four acres of private land, located in Romney Marsh, one mile from Dungeness, which is ideal for fishing, swimming and walking.

The service is also supported by a quality assurance team including a specialist learning disability advisor whose aim is to empower each individual to take control of their lives, and where possible, work towards a level of independence which fits with their skills, confidence and aspirations.

We offer person-centred support and encourage individuals to personalise their rooms to make them feel homely, and suit their needs and requirements.

Homeleigh Farm offers a variety of activities centred around individual needs. We are currently supporting people to achieve their set goals, which include going to theme parks and on holiday, and we are passionate about facilitating active support and involving people in a variety of tasks.

## Our services

- Specialist support for males with learning disabilities and behaviours that may challenge, as well as PWS and a forensic history of offending
- Accommodation comprising of 6 single occupancy bedrooms in a ground floor bungalow
- A range of communal areas, including a dining room, separate lounge, open plan kitchen, TV room and conservatory
- A large garden with a vegetable area, which residents help to maintain
- Ground floor living to allow easy access for individuals with mobility issues
- Innovative person-centred support programmes in a safe and caring environment
- Access to positive behaviour support (PBS) and psychology support
- A range of community-based activities, including horse riding, fishing and visits to the local library
- A rural location, approximately 1 mile from the small town of Lydd

## Achieving positive outcomes

By encouraging people to take control and have belief in their potential, we can make positive outcomes a reality for everyone, regardless of age or presumed ability.

We create pathways that support individuals through residential to community living, delivering measurable results for both local authorities and the people who use our services. ## Mark's story

Mark\* moved to Homeleigh Farm six years ago. Prior to moving here, he spent 15 years in prison, secure hospitals and institutions. Mark did not like spending money on anything and subsequently did not have many clothes. Mark did not maintain his personal hygiene and had never been on holiday.

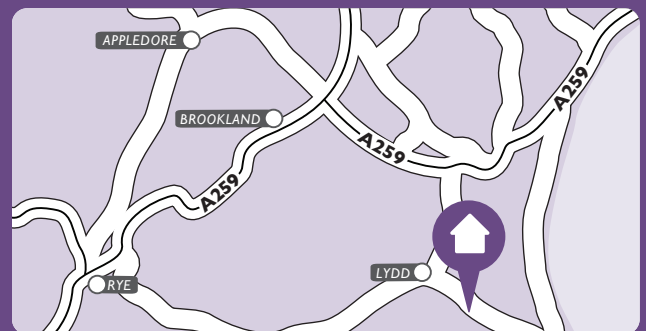
